Riders must be 17yrs & over. Horses must be at least 4yrs old.

Start times for Showjumping, Showing and Working Hunter classes are approximate depending on entries

DRESSAGE (9.00am) Entry Fee EFRA Members £8 Non-Members £10 per class .

- 1. BD Introductory (Walk/Trot) test B. Horses in this class may only enter dressage class 2a.
- 2a Prelim 2 (2016). Restricted to horse & rider combination who have never been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd in any dressage competition.
- 2b Prelim 2 (2016) Dryden Salver. Restricted to horses with no dressage points.
- 3. Prelim 18 (2002) Restricted to horses with less than 40 dressage points.
- 4 Novice 28 (2008). Restricted to horses with less than 125 dressage points.
- 5. Elementary 44 (2002). Scott-Plummer Rose Bowl.
- 6. Medium 71 (2002) Club Nut bowl.

Horses competing at Prelim level cannot enter Elementary or Medium.

SHOWJUMPING Riders 17 yrs and over Entry Fee EFRA Members £8 Non-Members £10 per class Start approx 1 p.m.

- 7. Beginner/Nursery (max. 65cms) An inviting course with no fillers
- **8.** Nursery (max 75cm). Sanderson Salver. Restricted to horse/Rider combination that haven't won money in any competition with jumping, or haven't been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd at Novice level and above or haven't competed in any BE Event.
- 9. <u>Novice (max 85cm)</u>. Burns cup. Horse/rider combination not to have won more than £20 in any competition at Novice level and above or been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd at Riding Club Intermediate level and above or competed at BE 100 level and above.
- 10. Intermediate (max ht 95cm) Pat Jeffrey Memorial Trophy
- 11. Open (max ht 1.05m) Stair Brown Cup

Horses entered in Classes 7 and 8 cannot enter Intermediate or Open. Horses in Intermediate & Open to be 5yrs or over.

SHOWING CLASSES Riders 17 yrs and over Entry Fee EFRA Members £8 Non-Members £10 per class Start approx 10 a.m.

There will be a rosette for the best coloured horse & best veteran horse over 15 yrs in each of the following 3 classes

- 12. Hunter Type Class Judged as a hunter class horses will be ridden by the judge. There will be no jumps
- 13. Family or Riding Club Horse will be required to jump 2 small fences max height 60cms
- 14. Cobs Cob type horse 14.2hh or over

WORKING HUNTER These classes may not run in this order. Start approx 12 Noon

- 15. Baby Nursery Working Hunter. Master Quaich. Riders 17 yrs and over For horse and rider combination who have not won any competition with jumping. Max ht fences 65cm. Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12
- 16. **Novice Working Hunter. Riders 17 yrs and over** Lucy Brown Cup. Horses 15hh and over and aged 4yrs and over. Restricted to horses that have not won two working hunter classes, or more than £20 in any class with jumping, or been In the top three in a BE 100 class or above. Max ht fences 85cm. **Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12**

17. Open Working Hunter. Wares Cup. Entry fee EFRA Members £12 Non-Members £15

This is a qualifier for Courier/BHS Scotland Riding Club Working Hunter Series 2018. (Final at Blair

Castle Horse Trials August 2018) Course approx. 1metre in height.. Class will be judged in line with Sport Horse

Breeding Society of GB rules. Open to horses 15hh and over. Horses must not have won more than £400 in total in any

WH competitions, no more than £400 in BS winnings or have more than 45 BE points. Riders must be 18yrs and over

on 1 Jan 2018. Hats must conform to current BRC rulebook. The first 3 will qualify for the final to be held in August
2016. If one of the first 3 has already qualified their qualification may be passed down to the fourth placed rider
provided they jumped clear.

To be eligible to compete in the final at Blair riders must be a member of a British Affiliated Riding Club

Working Hunter Championship (Fun Too Salver) for 1st and 2nd placings from classes 16 and 17.

18 RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12 - Start time 9 a.m. approx and will be confirmed

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. This class is a qualifier for the RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series FINAL.

The Series is open to AMATEURS only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.

The Judge will not ride at the qualifier but will ride in the final. The first three go forward to the final at the RoR National Championships at Aintree in August 2018

Rosettes 1st - 6th. Prizes - 1st £40 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £30, 3rd £20, 4th £10

Amateur definition:

An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season: Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses (for the show ring) in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard (in the current season or previous season).

Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season.

Horses and riders must not have received any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current or previous season.

Horses must not have been ridden at a show by a rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season.

Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

19 THE ROR/TBA (THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS ASSOCIATION) RETRAINED RACEHORSE CHALLENGE 2018 (UNAFFILIATED) Start time 10 a.m. approx & will be confirmed - Entry fee EFRA Members £10 Non-Members £12

The RoR Retrained Racehorse Challenge Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Riders must be 15 years old or over on the 1st January. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. All entries must be registered with RoR and HAVE raced in GB. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series Horses will NOT be ridden by the judge. Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the judge.

Rosettes 1st - 6th & Best Veteran Rosette (15yrs or over)

Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force

PHASE 1 Jumping to be judged:

8 rustic jumps (2' 6" to 3 foot with a maximum spread of 85 centimetres)

The following points to be deducted at the end of each jumping round:

10 points to be deducted for a knock down.

15 points to be deducted for a refusal.

20 points for second refusal.

Elimination for third refusal or fall

PHASE 2

Class returns without boots and judged for an individual show/conformation. (In some classes, at the judge's discretion, horses might be asked to do a 'show' following their jumping without leaving the ring. This is often the case with a large number in the class)

Each horse to complete an individual show of no longer than 1 ½ minutes. Show to include the following movements:

Walk, Trot, canter showing change of leg, extended canter (gallop) halt and stand, walk off on long rein. Total marks out of **30%** for Show, manners and suitability to be retrained

The class to be judged **50%** jumping, **20%** Style while jumping and performance and **30%** awarded for show, manners and suitability to be retrained.

New Hat/Body Protector Rules

Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying

with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are

acceptable at any BRC competition

- i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) and must have official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) and must have official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) and must have official SEI Mark
- iv) SNELL E2001 or E2016 and must have official SNELL label and number
- v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) and must have official SAI global mark

It is the riders responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower

specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may

invalidate any insurance

Body protectors must be BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label.

The ONLY exception to the requirement for a BETA Level 3 2009 purple label is that Exo Body Cages will continue to be accepted, provided they have a BETA Level 3 2000 purple label & the competitor must inform the event secretary
