WHAT IS VERSATILE TREC??

A Versatile TREC Horse competition is a three phase competition with set riding times but without the orienteering.

Phase 1. Obedience Test - this is ridden in a 20 x 40 dressage arena and the emphasis is on accuracy and obedience of the horse rather than paces & way of going. The test may include movements such as rein back and immobility for specific number of seconds. Marks are given to a maximum of 10 for each movement . Tests are printed in this schedule

Phase 2. Control of Paces (MA) in this phase the horse & rider canters/trots as slowly as possible along a 2m wide marked track which may or may not be a straight line. Once the horse has completed the canter/trot they then walk as fast as they can back along the track. Breaking pace or stepping outside the track it is zero points for that pace. It is scored on a sliding scale up to a maximum of 15 points for each pace.

Phase 3. Obstacle Course (PTV) In this phase there is a course of 10 obstacles that simulate what you might find out hacking - for example gate, narrow path, low branches etc. You may decline to do any obstacle without being eliminated but must inform the obstacle judge. Each obstacle has a maximum of 10 points. You may walk the course at the beginning of each class.

Competitors have start times for each section of the competition.

Class 1 - Starters

Novice Obedience Test (Walk / Trot) 25m MA (Walk / Trot) PTV = Level 1 Combination not to have been placed in any ridden Affiliated Arena or Full TREC or VTH Horse & Rider may be led/assisted but where necessary rider must perform PTV task – for example opening a gate.

Class 2 - Novice

Novice Obedience Test (Walk and Trot) MA 100m (Walk / Canter) PTV = Level 1Combination not to have been placed $1^{st}-3^{rd}$ in any Affiliated Arena or Full TREC or VTH.

<u>**Class 3 Intermediate</u>** Intermediate Obedience Test MA 150m PTV = Level 2Combination not to have been placed 1st in any Affiliated Full TREC competition.</u>

Class 4. Open Obedience Test MA -150m PTV = L2 Open to all

<u>VERSATILE TREC HORSE RULES</u> -Rules will be generally as per the 2nd edition (revised) TREC GB rulebook which can be found at <u>http://www.trecgb.com/Rulebook.html</u>

1. Horses must be a minimum of four years old . Mares more than four months pregnant may not compete.

2. . Hard hats conforming to 2018 BRC Hat Guidelines <u>must</u> be worn at <u>ALL</u> times when mounted with chinstraps <u>correctly</u> fastened. BRC Hat guidelines can be downloaded from the useful links page at <u>www.favershamridingclub.com</u>

3. Riders are strongly recommended to wear a BETA 3 standard body protector for the PTV phase.

4. Horses must wear the same tack (saddle and bitting arrangement) for all three phases.

5. Standing martingales and other fixed reins are forbidden. For led PTV obstacles the horse must be led using the reins taken over the head or a headcollar and leadrope. If a horse is ridden in a running martingale it must be led from a headcollar and rope for any led obstacles on the PTV

6. Whips must not exceed 75cm (1m for side-saddle). Spurs, if worn, must be rounded, not exceeding 3cm in length and point downwards.

7. The decisions of the officials and the Judges are final and must be complied with at all times. Competitors may be eliminated from the competition for any of the following reasons: • Excessive use of the whip • Dangerous riding • Abusive language

8. Please do not muck out box in the car park – there will be a muck trailer on site - please take all litter or place in bins provided.

HEALTH AND SAFETY The event manager/organiser has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the officials and stewards on the day. Trained First Aiders will be present at the event and should be summoned through an official in the event of an accident. Please take care to safeguard valuable tack and possessions. Young children must be supervised at all times. Neither the event manager/organiser nor the and/course owners can accept responsibility for loss or injury to persons or animals howsoever caused.
