Each Section has a Section Champion. Competitors placed 1st and 2nd are eligible to enter the judging for the Section Champion which takes place on completion of each section.

SUPREME CHAMPION, ***PERPETUAL CHALLENGE TROPHY***

All Section Champions are invited to take part in the judging to find the SUPREME CHAMPION.

Judging of the Supreme Championship will take place on completion of all relevant sections, c.2pm.

NB Sections 9 (Working Hunters and Style Jumping), 10 (Veterans and Misc), and 11 (Side Saddle) are not included in the Supreme Championship.

BEST FOAL ***EDDISTON TROPHY***

ALL foals placed 1st in their class are invited to attend the judging of the BEST FOAL, which will be judged BEFORE the Supreme Champion, c. 1.45pm.

RULES

This show is run under BRC rules except as stated below. This means that **HATS** must conform to EN1384, PAS 015 or higher and must be worn and fastened **at all times when mounted**.

The Organisers reserve the right to (a) cancel any class (b) divide or amalgamate any class (c) alter the advertised times

(d) refuse any entry without giving any reason.

Officials must be obeyed at all times. Abuse of officials, including verbal abuse, will not be tolerated and may result in elimination/disqualification.

SENIOR SHOWING & DRESSAGE LTD

The Olympia Anthony Evans SSAD Ltd Home Produced First Round Qualifiers are open to both affiliated and unaffiliated riders and handlers of the Senior Showing & Dressage Ltd. Please note all competitors should acquaint themselves with SSAD rules, these can be found at www.seniorshowinganddressage.co.uk. **6 Qualification cards** will be handed out in the ring at the time of presentation.

COMPETITORS ONLY NEED ONE QUALIFICATION CARD = IN HAND - ONE QUALIFICATION CARD = FOR RIDDEN CLASSES
IF ALREADY QUALIFIED THIS CARD MUST BE HANDED DOWN THE LINE

NEXT STAGE SECOND ROUND QUALIFIERS – You can only compete in the Olympia Anthony Evans SSADL Second Round Qualifiers, if you are a 2018 affiliated rider/handler and your animal is registered with SSAD Ltd and hold the 2018 member/registration card. Once you have qualified at a First Round Qualifier and you have received an **Acceptance card**, only then may you compete in the Olympia Anthony Evans Second Round Qualifier The Second Round **Champions** will go on to compete at the Olympia Anthony Evans SSADL Supreme Final at the London International Horse Show in December 2018 .

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers **MUST** have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available **FREE** from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

This Show is a qualifier and every horse & pony placed 1st and 2nd in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows as well as a wealth of other information.

SECTION 1 – HORSES UNDER SADDLE

Simpson Trophy

Judge: Jane Jeffries, Lumphanan

Classes commence at 9am prompt. The judge may ride.

- Class 1** Hacks, open to stallions, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, 14.2hh - 16hh.
- Class 2** Riding Horse, stallions, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, 14.2hh and over.
- Class 3** Small Hunter, stallions, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, 14.2hh to up to 15.2hh.
- Class 4** Hunter, stallions, mares or geldings to carry up to 12st 7lbs, 4 years old or over exceeding 15.2hh. **May be split by weight if entries allow.**
- Class 5** Sportshorse, stallions, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, 14.2hh and over.
- Class 6** Cob (Hogged or Traditional), stallions, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, to be shown under saddle.
- Class 7** Novice Ridden Horse, mares or geldings of any type, combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any ridden show class.

SECTION 2 –HORSES IN HAND

Maurison Perpetual Trophy

Classes commence on completion of section 1.

- Class 8** Stallions, mares or geldings 4 years old or over 14.2 and over hands to be shown in hand.
- Class 9** Colts, fillies or geldings born in 2016, 2015 and 2014 to exceed 14.2 hands at maturity.
- Class 10** Mare in foal or with foal at foot.
- Class 11** Foal born in 2017.

SECTION 3 - COLOURED HORSES & PONIES

The Crainnaig Stud Trophy

Judge: **TBC**

Classes commence at 10am.

Open to Skewbalds and Piebalds only. Classes may be split by height dependant on entries.

- Class 12** Non-native Ridden Horses and ponies Open to any size of horse or pony, 4 years old and over. Lead rein exhibits not eligible for this class.
- Class 13** Native Ridden Horses and ponies Open to any size of horse or pony, 4 years old and over. Lead rein exhibits not eligible for this class.
- Class 14** Coloured Youngstock Open to horse/pony born in 2016, 2015 and 2014. Foals born in current year are not eligible to compete.
- Class 15** Non-native In-hand Horses and ponies Open to any size of horse or pony, 4 years old and over.
- Class 16** Native In-hand Horses and ponies Open to any size of horse or pony, 4 years old and over.

SECTION 4 – RIDING PONIES UNDER SADDLE

Kingsford Sundance Trophy

Classes commence at 9am.

Depending on the number of entries received, classes may be divided.

- Class 17** Lead rein show/show hunter pony Mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 7th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Class 18** First ridden show/show hunter pony Mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Class 19** Mixed height open show pony Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, up to and including 148cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.
- Class 20** Mixed height open show hunter pony. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, up to and including 148cms. Rider must be correct age for the height of the pony they ride.
- Class 21** Mixed height novice show/show hunter pony Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, up to and including 148cm. Rider must be correct age for the height of the pony they ride. Combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any ridden show class. Canter optional,

SECTION 5 - RIDING PONIES IN HAND

Classes commence on completion of section 4.

- Class 22** Mare in foal or with foal at foot not to exceed 15.0 hands.
- Class 23** Foal born in 2017, not to exceed 15.0 hands at maturity.
- Class 24** Colts, fillies or geldings born in 2016, 2015 and 2014 not to exceed 15.0 hands at maturity.
- Class 25** Stallions, mares or geldings 4 years old or over, not to exceed 15.0 hands.

SECTION 6 - ARABS, PART BRED ARABS & ANGLO ARABS

Classes commence on completion of section 5.

- Class 26** Stallions, mares or geldings 4 years old or over, to be shown under saddle.
- Class 27** Mare in foal or with foal at foot.
- Class 28** Foal born in 2017.
- Class 29** Colts, fillies or geldings born in 2016, 2015 and 2014 to be shown in hand.
- Class 30** Stallions, mares or geldings 4 years old or over, to be shown in hand.

- Class 32** Small breeds, stallion 4yo or over. Open to any small breed, ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- Class 33** Small breeds, 1,2,3yo. Open to any small breed, ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- Class 34** Small breed broodmare in foal or with foal at foot. Open to any small breed, ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- Class 35** Small breeds foal born in 2017

- Class 38** Large breeds, 1,2,3yo. Open to any large breed, ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- Class 39** Large breed broodmare in foal or with foal at foot. Open to any large breed, ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- Class 40** Large breeds foal born in 2017.

Classes commence on completion of Section 8.

Depending on the number of entries received, classes may be divided by breed.

- Class 41** Open Lead Rein. Registered Pure Bred Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in current year. Ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- Class 42** Open First Ridden. Registered Pure Bred Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in current year. Ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- Class 43** Novice Ridden: Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age. Combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any ridden show class. Ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society. **No canter go round.**
- Class 44** M&M Open Ridden Small Breeds. Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age. Ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- Class 45** M&M Open Ridden Large Breeds. Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age. Ponies must be registered with the relevant breed society.

SECTION 10A - WORKING HUNTER PONIES

GUBRACH STUD TROPHY

Judge: Gary Charlish, Drumoak

Classes commence in the Working Hunter Arena at 9am.

Winners do not qualify for Supreme Championship

No competitor may ride more than one pony in any W.H.P class.

Classes 47-50 to be judged in line with BSPS rules and are two phase, 70% for jumping performance and 30% for manners, conformation, type and freedom of action. No change of saddlery will be permitted throughout the competition. Any suitable bridle may be worn. Spurs are forbidden and whip not to exceed 30ins in length.

Class 46 Leadrein/Assisted Wobbly Working Hunter Pony

Ponies not to have won any BSJA money. Height of fences not to exceed 1ft 3". Ponies can be led. Special rosette for best child under 12 years.

Class 47 Green Working Hunter Pony

Ponies not to have won any BSJA money. Height of fences not to exceed 2ft".

Class 48 Novice Working Hunter Pony/M&M Working Hunter pony

Ponies not to have been placed 1st – 3rd in any WH class, not to have won more than £30 BSJA. Height of fences not to exceed 2ft 6ins

Class 49 Open Working Hunter Pony

Height of fences not to exceed 3ft

Working Hunter Pony Championship for 1st and 2nd in Classes 46-49.

SECTION 10B – WORKING HUNTER HORSES

SADDLERS TROPHY

Judge: Gary Charlish, Drumoak

Classes commence in the Working Hunter Arena no earlier than 12 noon.

Winners do not qualify for Supreme Championship

Class 50 Green Working Hunter

For horses exceeding 153cm and over, and 4 years old or over which have never been placed 1st to 3rd in any Working Hunter competition. To be judged on style, conformation and may be asked to give a display. Max. height of fences 2'3".

Class 51 Novice Working Hunter

For horses exceeding 153cm and over, and 4 years old or over, which have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Working Hunter competition more than 3 times or won more than £100 in BSJA affiliated competitions. Max. height of fences 2'9". To be judged on the same basis as class 50.

Class 52 BHS Scotland/Dodson and Horrell BRC Working Hunter Series 2018

Horses must be 15hh and over. Horses must not have won more than £400 in total in any WH competitions, more than £400 in BS winnings or have more than 45 BE points. Riders must be 18yo or over on 1 Jan 2018. You will be asked to jump a course of 8-12 fences approx 3'3" in height. Classes will be judged in line with Sport Horse Breeding Society of GB rules. Hats must conform to the BRC rulebook. The first three partnerships in each qualifier will qualify for the final even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified, their qualification can be passed down to the fourth placed horse and rider provided they jumped clear. **To be eligible for the final, the rider must be a member of a riding club affiliated to BRC.**

Class 53 BHS Scotland/ Eastern BMW Working Hunter Series 2018

Horses must be 15hh or over, 4 years old and over. Riders must be 18 years old or over. To compete at the final, either the rider or owner of the horse must be a member of the BHS. Course: 8-12 fences approx 3'6", judged in line with Sports Horse GB rules. The first three partnerships will qualify even if they have not jumped clear. If one of these has already qualified, their qualification may be handed down to the fourth placed horse and rider provided they had a clear round in the jumping. rse approx 3'3" (1m) Open to horses 15hh and over, 4yo and over, not to have won more than £400 BS or in working hunter classes, or have more than 45 BE points. Riders 18yo and over on 1 Jan 2018. Class will be judged in line with Sports Horse Breeding of GB rules except that hats must conform to current BRC rulebook. The first 3 will qualify for the final to be held in August 2018. If one of the first 3 has already qualified their qualification may be passed down to the fourth placed rider provided they jumped clear. **To be eligible to compete at the final riders must be a member of a riding club affiliated to BRC.**

Class 57 PRE-SENIOR PONY/HORSE 15-18 YEARS OLD RIDDEN

Class 58 SENIOR PONY/HORSE 19-23 YEARS OLD RIDDEN

Class 59 SENIOR-PLUS PONY/HORSE 24 YEARS & OVER RIDDEN

Classes commence not before 2.15pm

Class 60 BEST TURNED OUT COMPETITION To be judged on the turnout of the horse/pony and rider/handler. Open to any age.

Class 61 BEST CHILD HANDLER Any child not to have attained their 12th birthday. Judged on the ability of the child to show pony in hand. Rosettes for all entrants. 1st & 2nd to go forward for best child handler trophy, after class 62.

Class 62 BEST CHILD HANDLER Any child between the ages of 12 years and 16 years. Judged on the ability of the child to show pony in hand. 1st & 2nd to go forward for best child handler trophy, after this class.

Judging for BEST CHILD HANDLER TROPHY

Class 64 RIDING CLUB PONY (14.2hh AND UNDER) mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, to be shown under saddle, to be ridden in a snaffle bit, no whip or spurs. May be required to do a small jump. 1st & 2nd to go forward for judging for **Drum Memorial Trophy**, after class 64.

Class 65 RIDING CLUB HORSE (OVER 14.2hh), mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, to be shown under saddle, to be ridden in a snaffle bit, no whip or spurs. May be required to do a small jump. 1st & 2nd to go forward for judging for **Drum Memorial Trophy**.

Judging for DRUM MEMORIAL TROPHY for overall best riding club pony/horse.

SECTION 13: Side Saddle, in conjunction with SSA

Judge: Jane Jeffries, Lumphanan

This section will be run under BRC rules therefore competitors must comply with BRC hat regulations. Judge may ride.

Classes commence not before 2.15pm

- Class 66 Side Saddle Unaffiliated Equitation:** Run under SSA rules defined the current Member's Handbook. Open to Members and Non-Members, Adults and Juniors.
- Class 67 Best horse or Pony Ridden Side Saddle:** Open to Horses and Ponies 4 years old or over. Conformation and manners will be taken into consideration. Horses / Ponies will not be stripped.
- Class 68 Champagne Challenge:** Riders are required to ride a set distance at trot carrying a small container of water, the rider with the most left in the container after completing the distance wins a bottle of Fizz!
- Class 69 Costume Concours D'Elegance:** Open to Side Saddle and Astride riders!! Judged on costume, elegance and harmony of horse/pony and rider in costume

DIRECTIONS

Cullerlie Farm Park (AB32 6XL) is situated on the B9215 between Garlogie and Raemoir.

The entrance to the showground is beside McIntosh Plant and will be sign posted.

Arriving from the West on the B977, pass the left turn (B977) towards Echt and then turn left into the park just past the McIntosh Plant buildings.

Arriving from the East, take the B9125 left fork in Garlogie and Cullerlie Farm Park is on the RIGHT after about 3 miles.
