#### **QUALIFIER INFORMATION**

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All England Jumping Course, Hickstead from Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2020. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in **Dressage** from Intro to Elementary, **Show Jumping** from Lead Rein to 1.05m; **Showing** for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, **Eventer's** Challenge from 60cm through to 1m.

**Qualification:**  $1^{st} - 4^{th}$  **place.** Qualification does not pass down the line.

Dress code for classes 30 & 31 is smart casual. All riders MUST wear a hat conforming to BRC Standards for 2020 and boots with a heel but may wear their own choice in between. As the name suggests these are fun supportive dressage classes to encourage those of you who want to have-a-go at dressage but don't want to dress up to do it., there is no need for show jackets and you don't need to plait! All we ask is you come, have a go and have fun! You may also enter these classes in traditional dressage attire if you wish.

<u>WITHDRAWALS:-</u> Must be made by Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> May. No refund can be made to anyone withdrawing after that date for any reason whatsoever.

**NUMBERS:-** To be collected from the Main Show Secretary on the day or you can use your own but please note numbers on bridles or saddle cloths must be on both sides.

#### **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. The Judges and stewards decision is final.
- 2. Every care will be taken, but no responsibility can be taken for injury, loss or damage to any person(s), their property or animals howsoever caused. All cars, trailers, boxes are parked at owner's own risk.
- The Organisers reserve the right to:
   Refuse any entrant without stating a reason for so doing.

   Alter the schedule, class(es) and prizes, judges as they deem necessary.
- 4. Any objections must be made in writing to the show secretary within 15 minutes of the incident occurring with a deposit of £20.00 that will only be returned if the objection is substantiated.
- All competitors must be correctly attired. Hard hats conforming to latest BRC Hat Guidelines <u>must</u> be worn at <u>ALL</u> times when mounted with chinstraps <u>correctly</u> fastened. All competitors in jumping classes are strongly advised to wear approved body protectors. - All riders / owners of animals on the show ground are responsible for their own safety and that of others. All persons to remain within the defined showground.
- 7. Any person(s) seen using whips or spurs with undue severity or mistreating any animal in any way will be asked to leave the showground and may be banned from all future FDRC events.
- 8. Practice fences and exercising areas are allotted, **<u>DO NOT</u>** canter, gallop or warm up outside of these areas or within the defined parking areas.
- Dressage entries to be received by post by Wednesday 13th May. No responsibility can be taken for entries
  delayed or lost in the post.
- 10. **Declarations:** All dressage entrants to report to the steward 10 minutes <u>before</u> their allotted time(s)
- 11. All Horses / Ponies entered in any ridden class(es) must be 4years of age or over.
- 12. DRESSAGE To be judged under BD rules. SHOW JUMPING To be judged structured on BS rules.
- 13. Entry fees will only be returned at the discretion of the organisers and on production of a valid Veterinary / Doctors certificate.
- 14. Horses must be up to date with their vaccinations and their passport should be available to check on site if needed
- 15. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU LEAVE YOUR HORSE BOX AREA FREE OF LITTER, DROPPINGS or HAY BEFORE LEAVING THANK YOU
