Eligibility Criteria for Horses AND Riders – as per current BRC Rule Book – please check. Seniors - 18 years and over. Entries in Open classes are limited. Qualifier classes for Teams and Individuals will be split for Area 1 and Area 22 members.

Arena Eventing consists of a course of show jumps immediately followed by knock down cross country fences, and will finish with the last fence as a show jump, the joker fence, which will be set at a discretionary 10 cm higher than the rest of the course. There will be a maximum of 20 jumping efforts, 9 SJ, 10 XC fences and the joker SJ fence. The joker fence is a compulsory fence and must be jumped, failure to jump the joker fence before passing through the finish will be classed as an error of course and penalised as per AE 1.6.1.

#### Area 1 Qualifier - ENTRY RULES

This competition will be run under BRC Rules. Anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition - please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document, which can be found at this link: https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook/

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and re-scheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of re-scheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued with a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the cut-off date which the Area will be informed about when re-scheduling.

**Entry Fees, withdrawals and cancellation due to circumstances beyond our control.** In the event of abandonment entry fees will be returned less and administration fee of £10 per entry. Clubs are liable to pay the entry fee for all entries as per their pre-entry to BRC, except in the case of abandonment.

**Equine Passports and Microchips** - It is your responsibility to ensure that your horse has up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is a checking device on the BRC website. If you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. As of 1st October 2020 it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable.

Numbers to qualify as per Appendix 10 in the current BRC Handbook.

All Classes will be in drawn order. Competition will start at approximately 9 am.

Please note all Championship Invitations are issued by BRC Head Office, as all results require to be verified.

- 1. <u>Club Representative / Team Manager</u> Each Club should nominate a Representative / Team Manager to co-ordinate entries, passports, number collection, etc.
- <u>Entries</u> All pre-entries (Team and Individual) AND qualifier entries must be made online by your Riding Club Representative / Team Manager to BRC HQ and Glenbrae RC, as per table overleaf. BRC HQ Pre-entry fees: £56 per Team / £14.50 per individual. ALL team members are automatically entered into the individual competition.

Open (non-qualifier) entries may be made direct by the rider (no pre-entries payable for Open classes).

- 4. <u>Body Protectors</u> A body protector (2018) is mandatory for this competition.
- 5. <u>Stop Watches</u> Stop watches are not permitted and must not be used.
- 6. <u>Number Bibs</u> Competitors must supply their own number bibs.
- 7. <u>Personal Information</u>: You agree that we may publish your Personal Information as part of the results of events and may pass such information to the governing body or any affiliated organisation for the purpose of qualification, insurance or for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compared to other events. Results may include (but not be limited to) name, club, times and age category.
