



PDRC Arena Event – Saturday 25 September 2021

At ELJ Equestrian, Hyndshawland Farm Stables, Elsrickle, ML12 6RD

NOTE: this is a reformatted event replacing the Mini One-Day Event at Dolphinton!

Arena event with jumping in two phases: first you jump a show jumping course of 7-8 jumps and then you go straight into the timed 'cross country' phase over working hunter style fences.

First aider will be present but no paramedics.

Combinations may compete in up to two classes.

First class to start at 9:30am.

Class 1: 60cm

Show Jumping Course & working hunter jumps: max height 60cm

WH speed 325mpm

Combination not to have competed in British Eventing in this calendar year.

Class 2: 70cm

Show Jumping Course & working hunter jumps: max height 70cm

WH speed 325mpm

Combination not to have completed a BE90

Class 3: 80cm

Show Jumping Course & working hunter jumps: max height 80cm

WH speed 325mpm

Combination not to have completed a BE100

Class 4: 90cm

Show Jumping Course & working hunter jumps: max height 90cm

WH/XC speed 375mpm

Open to all

Class 5: 1m

Show Jumping Course & working hunter jumps: max height 1m

WH speed 375mpm

CLOSING DATE: Sunday 19th September 2021 or once classes are fully subscribed.

For Show Jumping & 'XC' parts: Both horse and rider must be correctly dressed for XC riding. You will ride the SJ course first then going directly onto the WH course without stopping. Riders must wear current BRC standard hat with no fixed peak, they should carry EN1384 or BSEN1384 and another standard such as: PAS 015, VG1 01.040, ASTM F1163, SNELL E2001 or AS/NZS 3838. Body protectors are compulsory and should be BETA level 3 (purple label with year 2000 or 2009).

Arena Event Scoring:

The lowest cumulative score over both phases will win.

Fence Faults: all fences will be knock-down and will be equally weighted with faults scored as follows:

- Pole down: 4 faults
- First refusal: 4 faults; second refusal in whole section: 8 faults; third refusal in section: elimination.
- Error of course: elimination
- Fall of horse and /or rider: elimination

Time: the WH section will have an optimum time based on the speed stated above. Time will only play a role if the sum of jumping faults is equal; **in the event of a tie, the combination closest to the optimum time will win.**

With the emphasis on a fun event for all, competitors *may* be allowed to proceed after a third refusal, but this will be *entirely* at the judge's discretion and their decision is final.

We are aiming to have a photographer in attendance. Photographs taken will be available for you to buy, but may also be used on the PDRC website, Facebook page or in other publications to promote and celebrate PDRC's activities. If you do not wish your photograph or your child's photograph to be taken please indicate this on your entry.

PDRC will use your personal data provided with your entry for the purpose of running the event and by submitting your entry, you consent to receiving communications about the event by post, email, SMS/MMS, online or phone unless you explicitly state otherwise – see website for full Privacy Statement.

To enter you require to be either a PDRC or other British riding/pony club member or a BHS Gold Member or have personal insurance including Public Liability appropriate to this event and can show this documentation to the show secretary on show day or produce on request prior to the event.
